

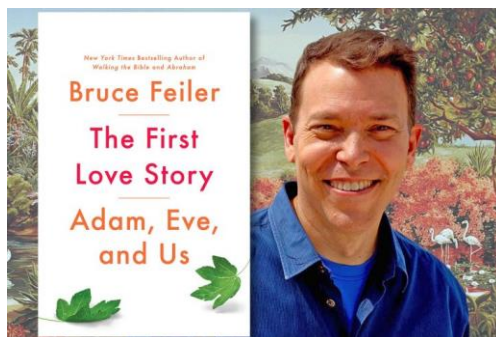

Feiler is one of America's most popular voices on contemporary life. Feiler completed his undergraduate degree at Yale University where he was a member of Ezra Stiles College, before spending time teaching English in Japan as part of the JET Program. This experience led to his first book, *Learning to Bow: Inside the Heart of Japan*, a popular portrait of life in a small Japanese town. Upon his return, he earned a master's degree in international relations from the University of Cambridge in the United Kingdom. For more than a decade, Bruce has explored the intersection of families, relationships, health, and happiness.
